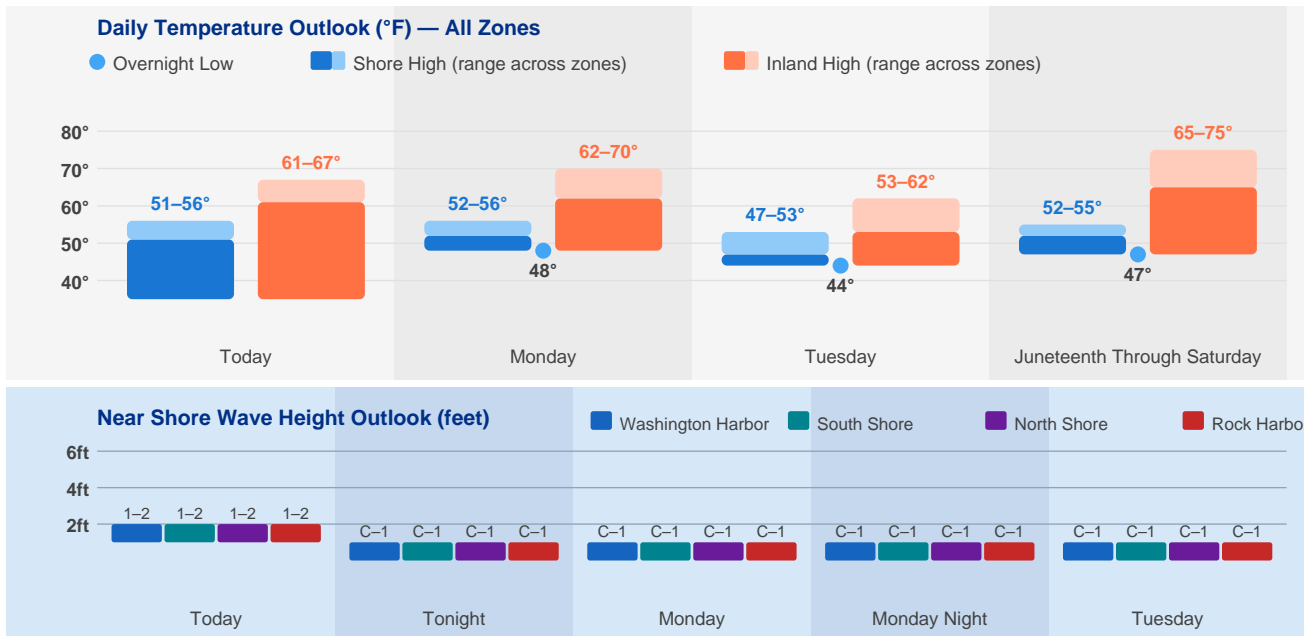

Marine Forecast

Lake Superior from Saxon Harbor WI to Upper Entrance to Portage Canal MI, 5NM offshore to the US/Canadian border, including Isle Royale National Park

Waves are the significant wave height — the average of the highest 1/3 of the wave spectrum. Occasional wave height is the average of the highest 1/10 of the wave spectrum.

Synopsis

A 29.8 inch trough will move through the lake this afternoon and evening. Weak ridging of 29.7 inches follows into Monday, but a 29.6 inch trough moves through the lake late Monday into Tuesday. This trough will deepen into a 29.5 inch low over northeast Wisconsin Tuesday. This low will then slowly move east-northeast into Ontario through Wednesday morning. A low of 29.4 inches moves then through the Great Lakes region Wednesday night and Thursday.
